

Red River UU Policy for Certification of Petitions  
Adopted July 21, 2009

Content:

Petitions submitted to Red River Unitarian Universalist Church must contain the following information:

1. A statement of purpose must describe the concern, position, or situation, include a specific request for action, and state the reason the petition is needed.
2. The statement of purpose must be printed at the top of each page of the petition.
3. Each signatory on the petition must be a voting member in good standing at the time the petition is submitted to the Board of Trustees.
4. Each signature must be accompanied by the printed name of the signatory and the date signed.
5. The petition can only be circulated by voting members in good standing.

Certification:

Petitions submitted to Red River Unitarian Universalist Church must be accompanied by a statement of certification signed by the member who circulated the petition. If multiple members circulated the petition, a separate statement of certification must be submitted by each member.

Sample Statement of Certification
